### What sets you apart?

- › You hold a European air traffic controller licence in line with Regulation (EU) No 2015/340 with at least a valid ASC rating and, ideally, have at least two years of experience using this rating
- › As an alternative to the European air traffic controller licence, you have a rating which qualifies you to work in upper airspace and, ideally, at least two years of experience using this rating
- › You have reached ICAO level 4 or better proficiency in English
- › You hold a valid medical certificate
- › You are prepared to participate in an assessment at the Karlsruhe control centre that will last several days
